There is an old orchard with pollinator-friendly understory, a linear orchard, espalier fruit trees along the retaining walls, a soft fruit area, several vegetable beds, a polytunnel, pollinator-friendly flower beds, a herb garden, raised beds (for people with mobility issues), a pollinator-friendly hedged area. The area also comprises of a garden shed, a compost toilet, a canteen, a clay pizza oven, a barbecue area, several beehives, a composting area, nest boxes, an insect hotel and education trail with signage for plants and birds. It is a tranquil space for time in the outdoors, education and social activity!
